

Application for CARES Act Funding

Deadline June 1, 2020

Franklin Pierce University has been awarded limited funds from the Federal Government to assist students with expenses directly related to the COVID-19 pandemic. These monies are intended to assist students with costs resulting from the disruption of academic programming. Requests for reimbursement of such expenses must be thoroughly documented and submitted with this application. **Funding is limited; there is no guarantee that Franklin Pierce University will be able to reimburse all applications for grant assistance nor that 100% of the expense incurred will be funded.** Every effort will be made to assist as many applicants as possible.

Some Examples of eligible expenses incurred after March 13, 2020 you can request CARES Act funding for:

Housing (lease extension, rental agreement); travel (plane tickets, bus tickets); technology needed for online coursework (laptop, computer, tablet); health care expenses; child care expenses; food; course materials.

Documentation reflecting COVID-19 related expenses must be submitted as part of this application.

NOTE: Per Federal guidelines, CARES Act funding cannot be used to cover an owed balance on your student account with the University.
