

Alumni Association Scholarship Graduate Studies Application Deadline: February 24, 2020

Master's and Doctoral Degree Students

What scholarships are available?

- \$4,000 for Master of Physician Assistant program (2 scholarships)
- \$4,000 for Doctor of Physical Therapy program (2 scholarships – 1 for each Goodyear, Ariz. and Manchester)
- \$2,000 for master's level program (2 scholarships)

Graduate Students are required to submit a completed application packet to the Alumni & Parent Relations Office. Applicants are required to:

1. Complete the application form attached
2. Write a one page essay on the topic outlined below
3. List three references

The Scholarship Review Committee will consider applicants who:

1. Are enrolled in a degree program at a center or online in the current academic year.
2. Demonstrate financial need (information provided by the OSFS at Franklin Pierce University – confidential information will not be released).
3. Have successfully completed a minimum of two courses toward their current degree and carry a 3.0 cumulative grade point average at Franklin Pierce.

2019-2020 Academic Year Timeline

- **February 24, 2020** – applications due to the Alumni & Parent Relations Office
- **April 10, 2020** – applicants notified of scholarships awarded

The Decision Process

Members of the Alumni Association volunteer their time to review each of the applications individually and submit votes to the committee chairperson. Each member of the committee reviews each of the applications individually and submits votes to the committee chairperson. The committee chairperson tallies the votes and forwards the results to the Director of Alumni & Parent Relations.
